19th Biennial Distinguished Building Awards Submission Information:

Eligibility:

Submissions may be provided by current AIA-EIC chapter members only, and may be for any project in any location completed in the last 4 years. Projects must be submitted by the authoring architect. Projects must be complete work, unaltered from the original design appearance and intended use. Projects must be a single group of buildings and related spaces.

Requirements:

Submission must include the following information:

- Completed Project Data Form
- Completed Project Authorship Form (Separate Sealed Envelope)
 - This is the only form that should include the architect and design team name.
- Complete Project Narrative Form (Limit to one page)
- PowerPoint presentation using template provided.
 - Do not modify format, except where directed
 - Do not include any information related to the project design team or architects name.

Submission Format:

Enclose all required information in a sealed blank envelope (9x12) labeled “AIA Eastern Illinois Distinguished Building Award Program” or submit all files electronically on CD or other electronic medium.

Categories:

Due to the limited number of entries, all submissions will fall under a general “Architectural Design” category and be judged on their individual merit of providing quality architectural solutions that enhances our built environment through quality design, sustainable initiatives, and thoughtful solutions, which advances the public perception of the architecture profession.

Jury:
