AIA Eastern Illinois announces this Call for Entries to its 22nd Biennial Student Awards Program for 2022/2023.

The Student Awards Program will honor high-school and college students who are pursuing an architectural education, to honor their excellent work in pursuit of their professional degree. This program serves to encourage students to continue pursuing their path to become architects. Participants may submit as many projects as they wish for award consideration. The size and budget does not limit its eligibility in any way.

Our chapter area includes the counties of Ford, Grundy, Iroquois, Kankakee, LaSalle, Livingston, Will, and a portion of southern Cook County that is outside of the City of Chicago and south of I-55.

JURY:

- Entries will be judged by a jury of architects and professionals.

FEES:

- There is no cost for student submittals

ELIGIBILITY:

- Student of any high school or college within the geographic boundaries of the AIA Eastern Illinois Chapter.
- Entries must conform to all the rules and requirements. Any non-conforming submissions will be disqualified.
- Projects must be submitted by the student

Once registration is complete a link will be sent to upload the project documents.
- Registration form must be received by September 29, 2023.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Complete the attached Narrative, and Student Forms
- Absolutely no identification of authorship is to appear on the Narrative Form, Plans or Images.
- Complete the attached Student Narrative Form describing the projects and classwork completed.
- Use the PowerPoint presentation template provided in the awards section of the website, <http://aiaeic.org/Awards> to create your submission. The template must not be modified in anyway and the PowerPoint should contain the following items:
 - a. List of architecture related classwork
 - b. Examples of completed classwork
 - c. Other Drawings optional (maximum of 10)
 - d. Photos (maximum of 10)
